## How to Include Picture A Cure in an Event

Work with your staff contact to order a Picture A Cure Relay/Advocacy kit.

Prior to your event, familiarize yourself with the contents of the kit:

- Picture A Cure forms (100)\*
- Pens
- Lapel stickers (100)
- Relay Advocacy Chair apron

At the event, take Picture A Cure forms around to campsites and ask people to insert their personal story about how cancer has affected their lives. Be sure that they include their contact information at the bottom of the form. Explain to them how their story will be used to urge lawmakers to support our efforts to increase funding for cancer research and programs that will save lives!

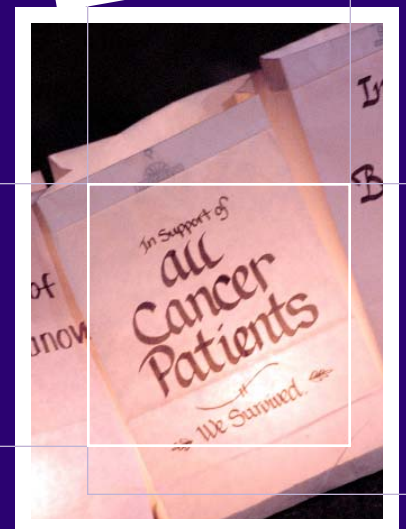
After the event is over, collect all the Picture A Cure forms and work with your staff partner to make copies to send to:
